

The Department of Epidemiology's SEAL Team provides students with experience in applied epidemiology through methods training and field assignments at state and local health departments.



Eligibility requirements: Graduate students in any department in the School of Public Health who will not graduate before Fall 2021 are eligible to apply. Accepted students enroll in EPI 594 in Winter 2021 (2 credits), one credit of EPI 594 in Spring 2021, and EPI 594 in Fall 2021 (1 credit). SEALs also have the **option** to take Surveillance Systems and Decision Making in Public Health (EPI 506, 2 credits) in Spring 2021 but this course is not required. Additionally, students will have the **option** of registering for 1 credit during Summer quarter, but they can remain on the SEAL Team without registering for credits. Students, regardless of summer registration, will still be responsible for field assignments during the summer quarter. In Winter quarter, the SEAL Team will meet on Tuesdays from 9:00-10:20. You will need to be available for class meetings during this time to be eligible for the SEAL team this year.

SEALs are expected to complete **1** or more field assignments **each quarter** that they are on the team.
