

The Department of Epidemiology's SEAL Team provides students with experience in applied epidemiology through methods training and field assignments at state and local health departments.

Eligibility requirements: Graduate students* in any department in the School of Public Health who will <u>not</u> graduate before Fall 2026 are eligible to apply.

Accepted students **must** enroll in:

- EPI 594 in Winter 2026 (2 credits)
- EPI 594 in Fall 2026 (1 credit)

In Winter, we will meet on Tuesdays from 9:00-10:20. You will need to be available during this time to be eligible for the SEAL Team. In Fall, we will meet on Fridays from 9:00-10:20.

Accepted students will have the **option** to take:

- EPI 506 in Spring 2026 (2 credits)
- EPI 594 in Spring 2026 (1 credit)
- EPI 594 in Summer 2026 (1 credit)

Regardless of enrollment in the optional courses, SEALs can complete field assignments through Spring, Summer, and Fall quarters.
